Purpose: Deltona Middle School's Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Academy is a hands-on/minds-on program that offers students a rigorous curriculum driven by problem solving, student choice, and discovery in a student-centered environment.

Criteria for Acceptance: Any current or future 6th, 7th, or 8th grade student attending Deltona Middle School may apply to the STEM Academy. Students will be chosen based on the answers stated below and overall student academic and behavioral performance.

Student Responsibilities: Students will be expected to participate in our annual STEM Showcase, the Amazing Shake, State Digital Tools or Industry Certification test, and completion of 6 voluteer hours.

**If students choose to participate in a competition, they will be required to attend after-school meetings and competition events.

Behavior Expectations: It is a great honor to be accepted into our STEM Academy. Therefore, STEM students are held to a higher level of behavioral expectations. Students are expected to display characteristics of perseverance and grit which will assist them in developing a strong work ethic. Students who exhibit consistent or extreme behavior that prevents those characteristics from being displayed by themselves, or their classmates, will be placed on Academy probation; which may result in the removal from the STEM program.

The Amazing Shake: The Amazing Shake is a competition that all STEM Academy students compete in. The Amazing Shake places an emphasis on teaching students' manners, discipline, respect, and professional conduct. Prior to the competition, students learn the nuances of professional human interaction as they are taught skills such as how to give a proper handshake, how to network, how to give a successful interview, and how to remain composed under pressure. The goal is to develop poised and ready individuals that can present themselves exceptionally well, given any circumstance that may arise, now or in the future.

Person to Contact: Interested applicants should complete the attached document by March 31, 2022 and return it to Mrs. Naylon. Selected applicants will be informed of their status in mid-May.

Costs to Students: The initial financial obligation for students in the program will be **\$40**. That amount will cover the cost of an Academy shirt to be worn on designated school days and to Academy sponsored events. The remaining fee will be used to offset field trip costs, materials, mission fees, and event costs. **Additional fees may be required if students elect to participate in a particular missions, such as competitions.

The STEM Academy is a rigorous hands-on/minds-on program. In the DMS STEM Academy, teachers are *facilitators* that ensure students become <u>independent learners</u> with the aim of preparing students for high school and future careers. With that focus in mind, students are required to be the primary active participant in their own learning and education by completing project-based learning activities (missions), which require students to drive their own learning beyond what they have previously been required to do.
